

And said mortgagors further expressly agree that in case of foreclosure of this mortgage, and as often as any proceedings shall be taken to foreclose same, as herein-after provided, the mortgagors will pay to the said plaintiff a reasonable attorney's or a solicitor's fee therefor, in addition to all other legal costs and statutory fees, said fee to be due and payable upon the filing of petition for foreclosure, and the same shall be a further charge and lien upon the said premises described in this mortgage, and the amount thereof shall be recovered in said foreclosure suit and included in any judgment or decree rendered in any action as aforesaid and collected and the lien thereon enforced in the same manner as the principal debt hereby secured.

The foregoing covenants being performed, this conveyance shall be void, otherwise this mortgage shall be in full force and effect.
