Hancock of Tulsa, Oklahoma, an undivided two-thirds (2/3) of the aforementioned three-quarter (3/4) working-interest, the same being equivalent to a one-half (1/2) undivided working-interest in and to the whole oil and gas lease covering the land hereinbefore described, but not including the producing gas well located thereon and known as Reed Well No. 1.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for themselves and their heirs, successors and representatives, do covenant with the said assignees, his heirs, successors or assigns that they are the lawful owners of the said three-quarter (3/4) working-interest in and to the above described oil and gas lease and the rights and interests thereunder and that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same or any part thereof.
