McLachlan, his successors and assigns, for the full term of said lease, subject only to the conditions in the lease contracts contained, and I hereby warrant that I am the legal owner of said interest in said leasehold estate and have good right to sell and assign the same, and that the same is clear and free of all encumbrances.

ASSIGNMENT

COMPARED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WHEREAS, on the 10th day of August, 1912, Ella Gravitt did make, execute and deliver to C. V. Reid, his heirs and assigns, an oil and gas mining lease covering the following described lands located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Township 20 North, Range 14 East, containing 50 acres more or less,

Whereas an undivided one half interest of said leasehold estate together with one half undivided interest of all equipment thereon is now owned by Benj. H. McLachlan;

McLachlan, have granted, bargained, sold, assigned, transferred and by these presents do hereby sell, assign, transfer, set over and convey unto the said G. W.
