THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into on this 23rd day of February, 1924, by and between W. C. CATES and W. C. Cates , Attorney for Roy Barnes, et al, as first parties, and TULSA INDUSTRIAL LOAN & INVESTMENT COMPANY, second party, WITNESSETH:

THAT , WHEREAS, first party , W. C. Cates, has applied to second party for a loan in the sum of Thirteen Hundred Fifty-five Dollars Twenty cents (\$1355.20), and said loan to be repaid at the rate of Sixty Seven Dollars Twenty-six Cents (\$67.26) , semi-monthly over a period of ten (10) months; and, ...
