Rufus Seven a citizen by blood of the Cherokee Nation, for the removal of the restrictions upon the elienation of her allotment (except his homestead), and am, as the result of that investigation, satisfied that the removal of restrictions upon the alienation of his allotted lands, except as to his homestead, will be for the best interests of the allottee, and I so recommend. The approval of this certificate does not in any manner determine the right of the allottee to any particular tract of land.
