PITTSBURGH, Pa., September 6, 1922.

I hereby certify that the following is a true and correct copy of the Minute of the meeting held by the Trustees of the General Assembly of the United Presbyterian Church of North America in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania April 12, 1921, at which six members were present a "full quorum", and at which the following resolution was adopted.

" The President reported that he and the Secretary had executed and delivered a Quit-Claim Deed dated February 1, 1921 to Annie Stein for the Church property of the Tulsa Oklahoma United Presbyterian Church to wit: The Northerly 70 feet of the Westerly 90 feet of Lot No 7, Block No 30 original town of Tulsa, now city of Tulsa, as shown by the recorded plat thereof. On motion, the foregoing action was ratified and approved. The consideration paid for said property upon which was erected a church building was \$10,500.00 most of which The following amount was paid to the Board of Church Extension, the balance was paid to the Home Mission Board.

On motion this action was unanimously ratified and approved."
