ACT OF INCORPORATION
OF THE

TRUSTEES OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY

AN ACT.

To Incorporate the General Assembly of the United Presbyterian Church of North
America.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Common-
wealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority
of the same, That James McCandless, Graham Scott, John Alexander, Thomas McCance, William
Getty, William M. Bell and David Reed, and their successors in office, duly elected as
hereinafter specified, be and they are hereby constituted and declared a body politic, and
corporate in deed and in law by the name, style and title of Trustees of the General Assem-
bly of the United Presbyterian Church of North America.

SECTION 2. That said corporation shall have perpetual succession, and the right to
hold lands, tenements, rents, annuities, franchises and other hereditaments, and all personal
