DEED OF TRUST. COMPARED

THIS DEED, Made and entered into this 14th day of March, 1924, by and between J. H. Traweek and Emma Traweek, his wife, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, parties of the first part, and M. Hughes Trustee, party of the second part, and the CENTRAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Marshall, Mis-

WITNESSETH, That the said part----- of the first part, in consideration of the debt and trust hereinafter mentioned and created and the sum of One Dollar to them paid by the party of the second part , the receipts of which is hereby acknowledged, do by their presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Confirm unto the said party of the second part, the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The North 31 feet 8 inches of the West 105 feet of Lot 8, Block 7,

Pleasant View Addition to the City of Tulsa,  
and Certificate number 894 being for Five Shares of "D" stock in the CENTRAL SAVINGS AND  
LOAN ASSOCIATION of Marshall, Missouri, and possession of said premises and said shares of  
stock is now delivered unto the said party of the second part.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE same with all the rights and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said party of the second part and to his successor hereinafter designated, and to the assigns of him and his successor, forever.
