Fackler, the receipt thereof being hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, assigned, set over, transferred and conveyed and by these presents do bargain, sell, assign, set over, transfer and convey unto Elmer E. Fackler, an equal 1/16 part of oil and gas produced and saved from certain lands in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, described as:

The South-half of the Southwest quarter of Section Thirteen (13),
and the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-four (24), all in Township eighteen (18), North, Range Twelve (12) east.

Under the terms of an oil and gas mining lease dated March 1st 1924, executed by E. E. Fackler and Elsie M. Fackler (his wife) and Walter Emrich (single) and running to me

To have and to hold the same, unto him, the said Elmer E. Fackler, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, for and during the term of the above referred to, oil and gas mining lease.
