ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

Lynch, the lessee in the above-described lease, hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns, and conveys all his right, title, and interest of the Lessee in and to said lease, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior to B. Jack Oil Company of Sapulpa, Okla.

Said assignment to be effective from date of approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior.
