Bunger, was plaintiff and Fred R. Hazen and Pearl J. Hazen, E. G. Maxey and P. A. McNeal, defendants, and after due hearing and consideration by the court, it was, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court, that the plaintiff have and recover judgment against said defendants Fred R.
