## A S S I G N M E N T

COMPARED

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of January, 1924, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between W. R. Martin and Pearl, Martin, his wife, lessors, and E. C. Funk and John T. Lindsay, lessees, covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section One (1) Township Sixteen (16) North, Range Twelve (12) East, containing forty acres, more or less, and said lease being recorded in Book 463 at page 193 of the Records of Tulsa County,

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of January 1924, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between J. S. Hopping, A.D. Kennedy, H. E. Kennedy, W. R. Martin and Pearl Martin, his wife, lessors, and E. C. Funk and John T. Lindsay, lessees, covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Thirty-five (35) Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Twelve (12) East, containing forty (40) acres, more or less, and said lease being recorded in Book 448 at page 312 of the Records of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, The said leases and all rights thereunder or incident thereto are now owned by the Riverland Company et al., the undersigned owning a full undivided one-fourth interest in said above described leases, subject, however, to a certain contract bearing date February 26, 1924, by and between the Riverland Company and the undersigned, E. C. Funk, John T. Lindsay, and Frank Bryan.

Now, Therefore, For and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owners of a full undivided one-fourth interest in said above described leases and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto to Thompson & Black, Inc. a Delaware Corporation, a full undivided one-fourth interest in and to said above described leases, subject to the terms and conditions contained in said leases, and subject further to the terms, conditions, and covenants contained in said contract between the Riverland Company and the undersigned bearing date February 26, 1924, together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to Thompson & Black, Inc., a Delaware Corporation, and its successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for themselves and their heirs, successors and representatives, do covenant with the said assignee, its successors and assigns that they are the lawful owners of an undivided one-fourth interest in said above described leases, and rights and interest thereunder, and the rights and interests arising under the terms and conditions of said contract between said Riverland Company and the undersigned; that the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interests and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
