Johnston of the post office of Mounds in the State of Oklahoma for and in consideration of Eighty no/100 Dollars, cash in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby (grant and convey) unto THE TEXAS PIPE LINE COMPANY of Oklahoma, a corporation of Oklahoma, (the right to lay, operate and maintain a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas, the grantee selecting the route, upon, over and through the following described land, situated in the County of Tulsa in the State of Oklahoma: E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 15, Twp 16 N Rge 12E,

also the Grantor at any time and all reasonable times shall
which are already Constructed along East side of above described land have the right of ingress to and egress from such pipe lines and remove the same in whole or in part at will.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easements unto said THE TEXAS PIPE LINE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA, its successors and assigns, so long as such structures are maintained.

And by the acceptance hereof the grantee agrees to bury such pipe lines so that they will not interfere with the cultivation of the land, and also to pay any and all damages to crops, fences and land which may be suffered from the construction, operation or maintenance of such pipe lines.

It is also understood and acknowledged by the grantor or grantors that the person securing this grant is without authority to make any agreement in regard to the subject matter hereof which is not expressed herein and that no such agreement will be binding on the grantee.
