ADMINISTRATOR'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made the 4th day of January 1924 by and between EXCHANGE TRUST COMPANY, a Corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, the duly appointed, qualified, and acting Administrator with the will annexed of the estate, of W. A. Greenwood deceased, party of the first part, and Hugh E. Robinson, party of the second part, witnesseth;

That, whereas, on the 6th day of December, 1923, the County Court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, made an order of sale, authorizing the said party of the first part to sell certain real estate of the said W.
