DECLARATION OF TRUST ESTABLISHING

THE MARION OIL CO. OF TULSA.

ARTICLE I.)

The trustees under this agreement shall be, unless and until changed, as herein after provided: J. L. Copeland; L. F. Copeland; J. S. Severson;

who shall sign and acknowledge this instrument, which signatures and acknowledgments shall be taken as conclusive evidence as to their appointment, the grant to them of the powers herein enumerated and their acceptance hereunder.

ARTICLE II.

The trustees, in their collective capacity and so far as practicable and convenient, shall be designated by and act under the name of THE MARION OIL CO. OF TULSA and under that name shall, so far as practicable, conduct the business and execute any instruments in writing in the performance of this trust.
