to the mortgagee or assigns as his or their interest may appear.

SECOND. That the first parties will pay all texes and assessments, whether general or special, lawfully levied or assessed on said premises before the same become de-

THIRD. That the said first parties will keep and maintain all improvements on the premises in good condition; commit or suffer no waste thereon, and not allow said pre-

FOURTH. Upon any breach of the first, second or third special covenants of this mortgage hereinbefore enumerated, as well as for the failure topay any part of the indebted ness hereby secured, either principal or interest, at the time the same become due, the holder of this mortgage may declare the entire sum or sums secured hereby due and payable, without notice and shall be entitled to a foreclosure of this mortgage for the satisfaction thereof.

FIFTH. In case of default in payment of any insurance premium, taxes or assessments, the holder of this mortgage may pay and discharge the same, and all such sums so paid shall be secured by the lien of this mortgage and draw interest at the rate of ten per cent per amum, provided that such payments by the mortgagee shall not operate as a waiver of the right to foreclose the mortgage under the provisions of the fourth special covenant hereinbefore set out.

SIXTH. Upon any default entitling the holder hereof to a foreclosure and if the indebtedness secured by this mortgage shall be collected by an attorney or through proceedings in any County, State or Federal Court, an additional sum of ten per cent of the amount due shall be recovered as attorney's fees and shall be included in any judgment or decree of foreclosure as a part of the indebtedness secured by this mortgage.

SEVENTH. Parties of the first part, for said consideration, do hereby expressly waive appraisement of said real estate and all benefits of the homestead, exemption and stay laws in Oklahoma.
