EASEMENT FOR ROAD  
PURPOSES.

COMPARED

IN CONSIDERATION of the payment of the sum of ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, William Walker, owner of lands located in the North-west quarter of Section 18, Township 21 North, Range 13 East, grants to Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, full rights and permission to enter upon and make excavations for the purpose of obtaining materials to be hauled and deposited in the roadway and approaches in connection with a bridge being built over Hominy Creek; said excavations and material to be removed from all or any part of the following described land,-

"Beginning at the North-west corner of Section 18, and running thence  
105 feet east; thence South 20 deg. East a distance of 260 feet; thence  
south 10 deg. West to the low water edge of Hominy Creek; thence North-  
westerly along the low water edge of Hominy Creek to the west line of Section 18,  
thence north along the west line of Section 18,  
to the point of beginning,"

And this agreement for Easements, shall also extend the privilege to the County for camping privileges to the teaming outfit on the lands owned by William Walker in the northwest quarter of said Section 18, while the work of making the roadway and approaches to said bridge is in progress.
