Bruner, Guardian of Stella Bruner, a minor, lessor, covering the following described lands in the Creek Nation, Oklahoma: Southeast quarter of Southeast Quarter of Section Six, Township Nineteen North, Range Twelve East (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 6-19N-12E); and whereas said Secretary has heretofore on Dec. 29, 1923, approved assignment of said lease (except as to oil and gas above the Mississippi Line) to M.
