NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC.

I, Olive E. Hollingsworth, after being first duly sworn, on oath state:

1st. That I claim and have a one-half undivided interest in and to the South one-half (S.½) of Lot One (1) in Block Three (3) of the Pershing Addition to the City of Tulsa Oklahoma by reason of the fact that A. L. Hollingsworth, or Link Hollingsworth, first began the purchase of same under contract in his name and collected money from me at all times with which to make payments before same was transferred to Lizza Martin who bought with knowledge of my interest in same and was therefore not an innocent purchaser, without notice and for value;

2nd. I have and claim a one half (½) undivided interest in and to Lot Sixteen (16) in Block One (1) of the Liberty Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma by reason of the fact that I worked, saved my money and helped to pay for same; that Lavora Hollingsworth is the daughter of A. L. Hollingsworth, by a former marriage and Richard Greer is the son-in-law of the said A. L. Hollingsworth, or Link Hollingsworth, and they both knew and know of the fact that I helped to buy and claim an interest in the same; that neither Lavora Hollingsworth or Richard Greer ever paid anything for said property and they are not purchasers in good faith or for value

3rd. That I have and claim a one half (½) undivided interest in and to Lot Seven (7) in Block Fifteen (15) of the North Tulsa Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma by reason of the fact that I worked and assisted in buying the same; that said property is the homestead of myself and my husband, A. L. Hollingsworth, or Link Hollingsworth, and I live thereon at this time and have so lived for a long number of years, continuously, peaceably, openly and notoriously; that the record title of this property is in the name of Lavora Hollingsworth, the daughter of A. L. Hollingsworth, or Link Hollingsworth, and Loyd Bolden, a stepson of the said A. L. Hollingsworth or Link Hollingsworth; that the said Lavora Hollingsworth and the said Loyd Bolden have never invested any money or other things of value in said property and the deed made to them is absolutely void and without consideration;

4th. That the said A. L. Hollingsworth, or Link Hollingsworth, is my husband and has been for the past 11 years; that with him and for him I have labored and toiled and given him money that I have earned with which to purchase or pay on the property above described; and that this is a notice to the public of my interest in same and of my determination to assert my rights and prove my claim.
