KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, =That

WHEREAS, the County Treasurer of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, sold the herein-after described tract, parcel or lot of land heretofore to said County, and the same has remained unredeemed for a period of more than two years from the date of said sale, and no person having offered to purchase the same by paying the treasurer the amount of all the taxes, penalties, interest and costs of sale and transfer, notice of the resale thereof was duly given by the publication of a notice of sale in the AMERICAN SATURDAY NIGHT a newspaper of general circulation published in said county once each consecutive week for four publications preceding the re-sale; describing the real estate to be sold; the name of the owner of said real estate as shown by the last tax rolls in the office of the county treasurer; the time and place of sale; the date on which said real estate was sold to the county for delinquent taxes; the years that taxes have been assessed and after delinquency added to the county lien; that the same have not been redeemed for a period of more than two years from date of sale to the county; the amount of all delinquent taxes, costs, penalties and interest accrued thereon; that such real estate will be sold to the highest bidder for cash for said taxes, cost, penalty and interest accrued on same, and remaining due, delinquent and unpaid, and on the 21 day of April, 1924, at a sale begun on the third Monday of April of the year 1924 between the hours of nine o'clock A.
