THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 24th day of May, 1924, by and between J.H. Waters and Marietta J. Waters, his wife, parties of the first part, and W.L. Doyel, party of the second part, WITNESSETH;

WHEREAS, a certain mortgage was made and executed and delivered on the 24th day of May, 1921, by C.W. McIntosh, a single man, to W.L. Doyel, to secure a note in the sum of \$2,500.00, with interest at 9 per cent, per annum, payable semi-annually, and covering

Lot Twelve (12) in Block One (1) of Orcutt Addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof.

AND WHEREAS, the property above described covered by said mortgage is now owned by parties of the first part; and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance under this mortgage, viz, \$1,600.00, is this day due in full and the parties of the first part desire to have the time of payment of said debt extended for three years;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of these premises and of other good and valuable considerations, it is hereby agreed between the parties hereto that the time of payment of the mortgage debt secured by the above described mortgage and the notes given to evidence said debt shall be extended for three years from the date hereof so that the same shall be due
