SHERIFF'S DEED

Know all men by these presents; That,

Whereas, on the 5th day of November 1923, in the District Court in and for the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, in a certain action therein pending, wherein W. M. Fewel was plaintiff and C. E. McCarrell, Goldena McCarrell et al were defendants, the said plaintiff W. M. Fewel by the consideration of the Court, recovered a judgement against the said defendants C. E.
