## ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE

Whereas, the Secretary of the Interior has heretofore approved an oil and gas mining lease, dated November 1st, 1912, entered into by and between Eastern Oil Company, a corporation, of Buffalo, New York, lessee, and John Buck, as guardian of Bruce Agent, a minor lessor, covering the following described lands in the Creek Nation, Oklahoma;

Now, Therefore, for and in consideration of One (\$1.00) dollar and other good and valuable considerations the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Eastern Oil Company, the lessee in the above-described lease, hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns, and conveys an undivided one-fourth of the right, title, and interest of the lessee in and to said lease, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior to Theodore Cox of Tulsa, Okla.

Said assignment to be effective from date of approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior.
