FARM RENTAL CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 14th day of June, 1924 by and between Elmer Lee Gilcrease of Winfield Kansas, party of the first part, and Sallie Fleetwood of Bixby Oklahoma, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made, the party of the first part has let, leased and demised, and does by these presents let, lease, and demise unto the party of the second part, for Agriculture purposes, for the term of two year from and after the 1st day of Jan. 1925 the following described tract of land lying in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma;

South West Quarter of the North West Quarter and two and one half acres on the North West Corner, all in Section Four, Twp 16, Range 14.

The said party of the second part, for the use of said land, agrees to pay to the party of the first part, as rent the sum of Fifty No/100 DOLLARS per annum during the term of this contract, payable as follows:

Twenty five Dollars payable January 1st, 1926.
