KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Whereas under date of June 9, 1924, a certain mortgage was executed by Nellie Walsh and J. H. Walsh, her husband, to Exchange Trust Company, to secure the payment of FOURTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$14,000.00) covering all of Lot Eight (8) in Block One Hundred Sixteen (116) in the City of Tulsa,

in Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

which mortgage was filed for record on June 10, 1924, and

WHEREAS, I was the intention that said mortgage cover only the Easterly Eighty (80) Feet of Lot Eight (8) in Block One Hundred Sixteen (116) in the original town of Tulsa, now City of Tulsa;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Exchange Trust Company does hereby remise, release and forever quit-claim all right, title and interest in and to the Westerly sixty (60) feet of Lot Eight (8) in Block One Hundred Sixteen (116) in the City of Tulsa, according to the official plat thereof, more particularly described as follows:--
