The West one-half ( $W\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southerly Fifty Feet (50) of Lot Three (3) in Block One Hundred eighty-two (182) of the Original townsite of Tulsa, Oklahoma Together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises unto the said W. P. Moore his heirs and assigns, so that neither Mrs. Effie Davis or any person in her name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and every one of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
