THIS AGREEMENT AND LEASE this day made and entered into by and between O. C. Peterman, of the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, party of the first part, hereinafter designated the Lessor, and J. O. Campbell, of the City of Tulsa, Tulsa, County, Oklahoma, party of the second part, hereinafter designated the Lessee.

WITNESSETH: That said Lessor for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth does by these presents demise, lease and let unto the Lessee the following described property and premises situated in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

One piece of vacant ground approximately 38 feet by 47 feet in size located in and a part of the South Half (S_{E}^{1}) of Lot Five (5) Block

One Hundred Eighty-one (181) of the Original Townsite of the City of Tulsa.
