That Hepsey McGilbra, now Spaniard, Fullblood Creek Roll No. 8019 and Joe Spaniard, her husband, part--- of the first part in consideration of the sum of Forty-four and No/100 DOLLARS (\$44.00) in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, part of the second part, the Following described real property and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Beginning at a point that is 203.48 feet North of and 33 feet East of the Southwest corner of the Southwest quarter (SW4) of Section Six (6), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, and running thence around the arc of a curve with a central angle of South 90 degrees, 20 minutes East, and a radius of 169.3 feet to the end of said curve and continuing thence East and parallel to the South line of said Section a distance of 1180 feet; thence South 8.25 feet; thence West a distance of 1358.73 feet to a point that is 24.75 feet North of and 24.75 feet East of the Southwest corner of said Section; thence North a distance of 178.73 feet; thence East 8.25 feet to the place of beginning, containing .44 acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma,
