Now if said part---- of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part---- of the second part heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then this mortgage shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money or any part thereof, or any interest there on, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when same are by law made due and payable, the whole of said sum or sums, and interest thereof, shall then become due and payable and said part---- of the second part shall be entitled to possession of said premises.
