RIGHT OF WAY CONTRACT

Wilson and Jennie Wilson his wife hereafter called grantors, hereby grant unto SINCLAIR PIPE LINE COMPANY, a Maine Corporation, hereafter called grantee, the right to lay, maintain, inspect, operate, replace, change or remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas on, over and through the following described land of which grantors warrant they are the owners in fee simple, situated in Tulsa County, State of Okla., to-wit:

together with the right of ingress and egress to and from said land for any and all purposes necessary and incident to the exercise by said grantee of the rights granted by this contract.

In the event the parties hereto cannot agree upon the amount of said damages, then the amount thereof shall be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons selected as follows: One by said grantor's one by said grantee and the third by two so selected, and the written award of said three persons so selected shall be final and conclusive on the parties hereto. Any pipeline laid hereunder shall be buried so it will not interfere with cultivation of the surface of said premises.

It is agreed that the terms, conditions and provisions of this contract shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
