Lots four to nine, inclusive, in Block Two, and Lots Four to Nine, inclusive, in Block Three, all in the Laffoon Addition to Skiatook, Oklahoma, according to the amended plat thereof.

That in making the exceptions in said deed he referred to a "mortgage to Sophia Daniel for \$1500.00"; this was a mistake as Sophia Daniel had no mortgage thereon; the exception should have been to the "mortgage to the Oklahoma National Bank for \$1500.00, that being the only mortgage against said property at that time and being the mortgage to which your affiant intended to refer.
