THIS INDENTURE, Made this 23rd day of June, A. D. 1924, between Clarence S. White (a single man) of Collinsville Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and J. O. Colburn the second part. 50

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred DOLLARS to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has remised, released, conveyed, quit-claimed, and by these presents does quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title, interest and estate and claim and demand, both at law and equity, of, in and to all of the following property, in Tulsa & Rogers County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The North-east quarter (1-4) of the north-east quarter (1-4) of Section thirty three (33) township Twenty two (22) north Range Fourteen (14) east Tulsa County, Oklahoma; and the northwest quarter (1-4) of the northwest quarter (1-4) of section Thirty four (34) Township Twenty two (22) north Range Fourteen (14) east Rogers County Oklahoma, containing in all eighty (80) acres more or less according to the United States survey thereof

This deed is made, executed, and delivered to the grantee herein for purpose of clearing title to said described tract of land by reason of a certain vendors lien for purchase money retained by the said Clarence S.
