THIS DEED, Made and entered into this 9th day of May, 1924, by and between Georgia C. West and husband, W. B. West, of Tulsa, Okla., parties of the first part, and M. Hughes, Trustee, party of the second part, and the CENTRAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Marshall, Missouri, party of the third part.

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the debt and trust hereinafter mentioned and created and the sum of One Dollar to them paid by the party of the second part, the receipts of which is hereby acknowledged, do by their presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Confirm unto the said party of the second part, the following described Real Estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Twelve (12), E.N. Adams Addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

and Certificate number 901 being for 9 3/8 share of "D" stock in the CENTRAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Marshall, Missouri, and possession of said premises and said shares of stock is now delivered unto the said party of the second part.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same with all the rights and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said party of the second part and to his successor hereinafter designated, and to the assigns of him and his successor, forever.

In trust, however, for the following purposes: WHEREAS, the said Georgia C. West and W. B. West, have this day made and executed and delivered to the said party of the third part one promissory note of even date herewith, by which they promise to pay to the said CENTRAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION the sum THIRTY SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY Dollars, said note being in words, letters and figures as follows:

NOTE OR OBLIGATION

One hundred months after date, for value received, we promise to pay to the CENTRAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Marshall, Mo., THIRTY SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY Dollars, this day advanced to me as a loan, with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable in monthly installments of Eighteen & 75/100 Dollars each, and the further sum of Nine & 37/100 Dollars per month, for premium on said loan so made to us by said CENTRAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Marshall, Mo., and we further agree to pay said Association, at the same time said interest and premium are payable the sum of Twenty Eight & 13/100 Dollars
