T. WRIGHT, 227 Lynch Building, Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereinafter designated as "Assignee", the following described leasehold, premises and property:

1. All of its right, title and interest in and to a certain lease for oil and gas mining purposes wherein E. B. Maxey, Henry Hornecker and G. T. Brown were lessors, which lease was dated the 3rd day of June, 1916, and is now owned by assignor, the same covering the following described tract of land in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:
