

"First Mortgage 6% Serial Gold Bonds";

And Whereas, said mortgage provided that upon the payment of all of the bonds and coupons thereby secured and the performance of all of the covenants and conditions of said indenture that the Trustee and or Co-Trustee shall have and are given power to cancel and discharge said indenture and execute and deliver to the mortgagor such deeds and other instruments as shall be requisite to satisfy and discharge the lien thereof and reconvey the property thereby covered to the mortgagor;

And Whereas, all of the bonds and coupons secured by said indenture have been paid and cancelled and all of the covenants and conditions of said indenture have been fully kept and performed;
