RESOLUTION

A Resolution releasing sewer easement covering Lot 120, Block 15, Southside Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, under date of November 20th, 1922, the City of Tulsa, acquired by a sewer contract, an easement on, over and across Lot 120, Block 15, Southside Addition for the purpose of constructing sewers on, over and across said described property, and

WHEREAS, it now appeared that the said easement for sewer purposes in superfluous with the exception of reserving the right of maintaining and repairing the sewers now in place on said described property;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONS OR THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA.:

SECTION 1. That the City of Tulsa hereby releases its sewer easement on, over and across Lot 120, Block 15, Southside Addition to the City of Tulsa, reserving and retaining the right however, to maintain, operate and keep in a good state of repair sewers now on said described property.

SECTION 2. That in emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, whereof, this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage, and approval.
