GRANT R. McCULLOUGH, being duly sworn, on oath deposes and says;

That he is the same person to whom was given and delivered a Warrant Deed by George W. Rose, and Grace Rose, his wife, dated November 19th, 1910, filed for record in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, November 22nd, 1910, and recorded in Book 87 at page 456, whereby said grantors granted to this affiant Lot 5 in Block 6 of East Lynn Addition to the City of Tulsa, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, and that he is also the same person to whom the Sheriff of Tulsa County, under date of July 9th, 1912, executed and delivered a Warranty Deed filed for record in the office of the County Clerk ex officio Register of Deeds of said County and State on November 12th, 1913, which deed now appears on record in Book 162 at page 41.

AFFIANT further states that he is one and the same person designated as G. R. McCullough, as one of the plaintiffs in a cause No- 2739 in the District Court within and for said County and State, wherein Oklahoma National Bank, a corporation, Pawnee National Bank of Pawnee, Oklahoma, a corporation, Quincy National Bank of Quincy, Illinois, a corporation and G. R. McCullough, this affiant, were plaintiffs, and George W. Rose and Grace Rose and others were defendants; that judgment was obtained in said cause against the above named defendants, along with the other defendants named in said cause, and execution was issued against the property of said defendant George W. Rose; that the property hereinabove described was levied upon by the Sheriff of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, pursuant to an order issued out of the District Court in the above entitled cause; that said property was sold and this affiant purchased the above described property at the Sheriff's Sale, in his name; that with the consent of the said plaintiffs hereinabove set forth in said cause, upon the sale of said property this affiant took title as Trustee for himself and the other plaintiffs hereinabove mentioned; that in reality this affiant was Trustee for himself and the other plaintiffs, and that he, acting in the same capacity, conveyed all of his right, title and interest, and all of the right, title and interest of each of the other persons for whom he was acting, to Rosco Adams, as is shown by a deed dated February 20th, 1917, filed for record February 21, 1917, in the office of the County Clerk ex officio Register of Deeds of said County, and now recorded in Book 214 at page 139; that each and all of said parties for whom this affiant
