

required, and by publication in the Oklahoma Eagle, a weekly newspaper, published and printed regularly in the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, as by law requires; Thereupon, witnesses are produced, sworn and testified in support of the material allegations of the petition filed herein, and after a full hearing and consideration of same, and the court being fully advised in the premises, makes the following findings, and judgments,

- I -

That the decedent, Lonnie Williams died intestate, a resident of Tulsa County, Oklahoma on the 20th day of December 1920 seized of lot 12 block 3 of the Rosedale Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,

- II -

That said described property was acquired by the decedent subsequent to his marriage to Gene Williams, and by their ^{joint} ~~joint~~ earnings that is, was acquired by the joint industry of Lonnie Williams and Gene Williams as husband and wife during coverture; that there was no issue as the result of said marriage; and that said real estate was the homestead of Lonnie Williams and Gene Williams at the time of the death of Lonnie Williams.

- III -

That the appointment of administrator of the estate of Lonnie Williams, deceased, the giving notices of said appointment, and notices to creditors have been complied with as by law required.

- IV -

That more than six months have elapsed since the publication of notice to creditors and since the appointment of administrator and the issuing of letters testamentary; that the above real estate is all the property of which the deceased died seized; that Gene Williams is the surviving spouse of Lonnie Williams, deceased and entitled to a decree to this court adjudging her to be the absolute owner of the whole of the above described real estate in fee simple, free and clear of any right or claim of the brothers and sisters whose names are set forth in the petition filed herein; that notice of this hearing has been given said said brothers and sisters as by law provided,

- V -

That there is no property to be further administered upon; no debts presents against said estate; and further administration should be dispensed with and this estate closed,

Therefore, it is by the court ordered, adjudged and decreed that Gene Williams is the surviving spouse of Lonnie Williams, deceased; that the real estate above described was acquired by the joint industry of Lonnie Williams and Gene Williams during coverture, and as such surviving spouse Gene Williams is entitled to the whole of said real estate.

It is further ordered adjudged and decreed that Gene Williams be, and she is hereby given the whole of said real estate, to-wit; Lot Twelve (12) in Block three (3) of the Rosedale Addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma, free and clear of any claim of the brothers and sisters of the said Lonnie Williams or any person claiming by or thru them or either of them, to have and to hold unto herself, and her heirs or personal representatives forever;

It is further ordered adjudged and decreed by the court that this estate be and the same is hereby closed, and the administratrix discharged,
