Know all men by these presents, That George Island, and Callie Island, his wife parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Seventy Four & 15/100 (\$174.15) dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant, bargain sell and convey unto Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, party of the second part, for the purpose of being used as public highway, the following described real estate property and premises, situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit;

A strip of land 50 feet in width, for highway right of way purposes, through the Southeast Quarter of Section 12, Township 19 North, Range 10 East. the northerly line of which follows the southerly right-of-way line of the A. V. & W. Railroad, thru said tract of land, and containg 3.1 acres more or less,

To have and to hold said above described land unto the said Tulsa County, so long as same shall be used for a public highway only, but should said land herein conveyed cease to be used and maintained as a public highway, then, in such event, said land shall revert to the grantor heirs or assigns,

Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, party of the second part, for the purpose of being used as public highway, the following described real estate prpperty and premises, situated in Tulsa County, Stateof Oklahoma, to-wit;

"Beginning at theintersection of the south right of way line of the St. L. & S. F. Railroad with the north and south center line of Section 12; Township 19 North, Range 10 East said intersection being 2179.8 feet north of the south line of said section 12; thence South 86 feet; thence North 74 deg, 47 min, East a distance of 368.9 feet to the point of a curve having a radius of 548.7 feet and an angle to the rightof 5 deg, 1min; thence around the arce of said curve a distance of 48 feet to the end of said curve; thence north 79 deg, 48 min, East a distance of 360.3 feet to the point of a curve with a radius of 548.7 feet and a
