a good workmanlike manner; to commit no waste thereon; to not alter said presmises exept as nay be herein provided; to at all times plow and tend said premises to the best advanage of and the lessor; and to turn same over to the lessor at the expiration or this lease in as good. condition as they now are, the usual wear, inevitate accidents; and loss by fire excepted,

Any repairs made on the fences and buildings on said lands by the lessee, shall be considered to be done for the convenience of the lessee and for which he shall received no pay from the lessor, and the same shall become a part of the premises,

and it is further agreed that if the lessee shall fail to pay the rents when due, or construct or place improvements an said land, as contracted for in the manner herein provided or fail to comply with or violate any of the provisions of this contract, the lessor may, at his option, declare the lease forfeited by giving notice as required by law, and may thereupon re-enter and take possession of said premises and ject the lessee therefrom, but such forfeiture shall not release the lessee from paying all rents contracted for nor from damages for failure or violation,

The said lessee further covenant and agree that at the expiration of the time mentioned in this lease he will deliver upothe possion of the premises herein described, peacefully and without legal process for the recovery thereof;

It is txpressly understood and agreed by the parties hereto that any sub-lease, assignment or transfer of this lease, or of any interest therein or therunder, may be made only with the consent and approval of the cupertendent for the Five Civilized Tribes, and any assignment of transfer made or attempted to be made without such consent and approval shall

The covenants and agreements hereinbefore mentioned shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, assigns, executors, and administrators of the parties to this lease,
