Patties of the first part and their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, well warrant the quiet enjoyment of the aforesaid premises to the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors and assigns, and will forever defend the aforemaid premises against the lawful claims and demands of all persons,

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD that the said second party may pay any taxes and assessments levied against said premises or **any** other sum necessary to protect the rights of such party or its assigns, including insurance upon buildings, and recover the same from the first party with ten per cent, interest, and that every such payment secured hereby, and that in case of a foreclosure hereor and as often as any foreclosure hereor may be filed , the holder hereof may recover from the first party an attorney fee of (\$350.00) Dollars, or such different sum as may be provided for by said note, which shall be due upon the filing of the petition in foreclosure and which is secured hereby, and which the first party promises and agrees to pay, together with expense of examination, or tatle in preparation for foreclosure Any expense incurred in litigation or othersiwe, including Attorney fees and abstract of title to said premises insured by reason of this mortgage or to protect its liens, shall be repaid by the mortgagar to the mortgagee or assigns, with interest thereon at 10 per cent, per annum, and this mortgage shall stand as security therefor.
