

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 20th day of October 1908 A. D. 190, between James D. Ward, and Eva G. Ward, his wife, of Collinsville, Rogers County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part and Albert Patterson and Charles J. Waite, both of Chillicothe Missouri and Jonathan William Carlstrom of Tulsa Oklahoma of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred and no DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described Real Estate, Situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The east half of the south west quarter of the south west quarter and the west half of the south east quarter of the south west quarter and the southeast quarter of the south east quarter of the south west quarter all in section thirty three (33), Township twenty two (22), range thirteen (13) East.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the Tenements, Hereditaments and Appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining forever.

And said James D. Ward and Eva G. Ward for their heirs, executors, or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said parties of the second part that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of and absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of and to all and singular, the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other Grants, Titles, Charges, Estates, Judgments, Taxes, Assessments, and Encumbrances, of what nature or kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend title to the same unto said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part, and their heirs, and all and every person or persons, whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
