MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT.

THIS ACREEMENT made and entered into in triplicate this 4th day of February, 1924, by and betweenthe Hancock Oil Company and the Buckles Oil Corporation, both of Tulsa, Oklahome, parties of the first part, and the Alta Sales Corporation, a corporation of New York, party of the second part,

VWITNESSETH:

Whereas the parties of the first part are the owners of an oil and gas lease located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:

An oil and gas lease dated the 10th day of June, 1920 in which W. L. Britton and Elsie Britton, husband and wife, are lessors and the Hancock Oil Company is lessee, covering the following described land:
