GAS MINING LEASE.

OSAGE RESERVATION, OKLAHOMA.

This lease, made and entered into in quadruplicate, on this 15th day of April, A.D. 1916, by and between the Osage Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma, by A-she-gah-hre, Principal Chief, under authority of the resolution of the Osage Tribal Council, dated June 17th, 1915, party of the first part, designated as lessor, and Charles Owen, of Caney, Kansas, party of the second part, designated as lessee, under and in pursuance of Section 3 of the Act approved June 28, 1906 (35 Stat.L., 539, 543) witnesseth:

1. The lessor, in consideration of One dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions herein contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee, does hereby demise, lease and let unto the lessee for the period commencing March 17th, 1916, and expiring April 8, 1931, with the privilege of renewal upon such terms as may be agreed upon should the time during which the title to the minerals remains in the Osage Tribe of Indians be extended, all the gas deposits in or under certain lands situated in Osage County, in the State of Oklahoma, and more particularly described as follows:
