KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, C. H. Terwilliger, joined by mywife Mary A. Terwilliger, for and in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is acknowledged, do hereby grant and dedicate to the Public as and for a Right of Way, Easement, Highway and Street for free and uninterrupted use by the public as a street and highway, that certain tract or parcel of land, being a part of Lots Nine, Ten and Eleven in Block Eleven of Terwilliger Heights Addition to the city of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west line of Lot 11, Block 11, Terwilliger Heights Addition, said point being eight and fifty five hundredths (8.55) feet south of the Northwest corner of said Lot, thence North along the west line of said Block a distance of sixty (60) feet; thence East along the East projection of the North line of Twenty fifth Street to the East line of said Block thence Southernly along the East line of said Block to the point where the East projection of the South line of Twenty fifth Street intersects the East line of said Block; and thence Westernly along the Easternly projection of the South line of Twenty fifth Street to the point of beginning.
