be and the same is hereby added to and annexed to the said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the corporate limits of said City be and same hereby are extended to include said tract of land for all purposes.

SECTION 2. That the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereby retains and reserves a perpetual easement and right to enter upon and use any portion of the above described tract of land and to build, construct, lay, maintain, alter or repair any sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, telephone lines, telegraph lines, electric lines or any other public utilities.

SECTION 3. That from and after this ordinance takes effect the real estate described in Section 1, hereof, shall be a part of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and all persons residing therein and all property situated thereon, shall be and are hereby declared to be subject in all respects and particulars to the jurisdiction, control and laws and ordinances of said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

SECTION 4. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 2590.

An Ordinance adding and annexing to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma a certain tract of land, known as RESERVOIR HILL ADDITION to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the duly recorded plat thereof and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma that a certain tract of land known as RESERVOIR HILL ADDITION, an addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, hereinafter particularly described, lying in Tulsa County, Oklahoma and lying contiguous to and adjoining the present corporate limits of said City, is surrounded on three or more sides by the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa and abuts on the City of Tulsa on three or more sides, and,

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners that the said tract of land hereinafter described should be added and annexed to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma and included within the corporate limits of said City, and it further appears that said tract of land is not in excess of forty (40) acres.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That a tract of land hereinafter described, the same being known as
