

lines, telephone lines, telegraph lines, electric lines or any other public utilities.

SECTION 3. That from and after this ordinance takes effect the real estate described in Section 1, hereof, shall be a part of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and all persons residing therein and all property situated thereon, shall be and are hereby declared to be subject in all respects and particulars to the jurisdiction, control and laws and ordinances of the said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

SECTION 4. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

PASSED and the emergency clause ruled upon separately and approved, this 22 day of April 1924.

ORDINANCE NO. 2770.

An Ordinance vacating the alley in Block One (1) Morningside Addition to the city of Tulsa Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof, with certain reservations, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by the owners in fee of all the property in Block One (1) Morningside Addition, Tulsa, Oklahoma, has been presented to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, asking that the alley therein described to wit, the alley running north and south in Block One (1), according to the official plat thereof, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned as a public alley of said city.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the alley running north and south in Block 1, Morningside Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned as a public alley of said City.

SECTION 2. Provided however, that the City of Tulsa hereby reserves and shall retain forever, the right to construct, reconstruct, repair, maintain and operate sanitary sewers and other appurtenances thereto appertaining, now located in said alley or which of necessity should be constructed or maintained in said alley, with the right of ingress and egress over and through said premises for the purposes above indicated, and for said purposes four (4) feet on each side of the center line of said alley is hereby maintained by the city of Tulsa, upon which said city of Tulsa, may allow public service corporations, companies, individuals or itself, to construct, maintain, and operate facilities for public utilities, including poles, wires, pipes, conduits, and other necessary accessories; and,

Provided further, that four (4) feet on each side of the center line of said alley shall be construed to mean sufficient space near the center of said alley for the purposes above specified; and provided further, that the above vacation is made subject to the conditions and provisions of Paragraph 11 of Section 6, of Article 11 of the Charter of the City of Tulsa.
