

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance insofar as such conflict exists, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public welfare and safety, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

An ordinance accepting and adding to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a certain tract of land known as RESERVOIR HILL ADDITION, to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a petition in writing has been presented to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma signed by the sole property owner of the tract of land herein described and designated as Reservoir Hill Addition, to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and lying contiguous to and adjoining the present corporate limits of said City, which petition prays that said Board annex to said City of Tulsa, said tract of land; and,

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear upon examination, by said board that the tract of land herein described is platted into lots and blocks and is used for residential purposes, and it further appearing to said Board that the prayer of said petitioner should be granted and the land embraced in said petition should be annexed to said City that all things necessary to be done for the proper annexation of said tract of land to said city have happened and been performed, and that said action is for the benefit of all parties concerned.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLA.

SECTION 1. That a tract of land hereinafter described, the same being known as RESERVOIR HILL ADDITION to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, as recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and adjoining the present corporate limits of said City, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

#1. twenty-six (26) Township twenty (20) North, Range

Reservoir Hill Addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma, the same being a subdivision of a tract of land described as follows:

All of lot Five (5) and the North East one Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the North East one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twelve (12) East, Tulsa County Oklahoma, except the following described tract of land included therein, to-wit: Beginning at Southwest corner of Lot Five (5), Section twenty six (26), running thence North along the ninety-sixth (96th) Meridian seven hundred nine (709) feet; thence East three hundred eighty six (386) feet; thence South thirty five (35) degrees fifty one (51) minutes East two hundred eighty three (283) feet; thence South four hundred seventy nine and thirty eight hundredths (479.38) feet; thence West five hundred fifty one and seventy five hundredths (551.75) feet to place of beginning, containing eight and fifty four hundredths (8.54) Acres, more or less, said tract being part of lot five (5), Section Twenty six (26) Township twenty (20) North, Range Twelve (12) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma; excepting also the North 330 feet of the East 975 feet of said Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said section 26, Township 20 North, Range 12-East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
