the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma; and that the corporate limits of said City be and the same are hereby extended to include the above described tract of land.

SECTION 2. That 'the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereby retains and reserves a perpetual easement and right to enter upon and use any portion of the above described tract of land to to build, construct, lay, maintain, alter or repair, any sewer line, water lines, gas lines, telephone lines, telegraph lines, electric lines, or any other public utilities.

SECTION 3. That from and after this ordinance takes effect the real estate described in Section 1, hereof, shall be a part of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and all persons residing therein and all property situated thereon, shall be and are hereby declared to be subject in all respects and particulars to the jurisdiction, control and laws and ordinances of the said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

SECTION 4. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

PASSED, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately and approved, this 5th day of December 1924.
