And it appearing that heretofore, on the 13th day of March, 1923, the said L.B.

The west half (W1) of the southwest quarer (SW1) of (SE1) the southeast quarter/of section fifteen (15) township nineteen(19) north, range twelve (12) East

To have and to hold the said mentioned tracteor parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, to the said party of the second part, W.R.Ritchie, his heirs and assigns, forever, in as full and ample maner as the said Treasurer of said County is empowered by law 10 sall the same.
